Last month the Krishna from the not for profit Community Care Chemist, spoke about healthy living, nutrition and wellness plus she will update us on the new pharmacy services that the Government have introduced. She followed up some of our questions with a list of conditions that a pharmacist can help us with without a visit to a doctor.

Thank you so much again for having me as a guest speaker last week! It was a pleasure to share information around our organisation with the club, and I welcome any additional queries.

I have a consolidated list of prescribing that our pharmacists can currently do. This will expand over the coming couple of years, and not all relevant to our current club members, however at the moment it is:

- UTI treatment for women aged 18 to 65
- Represcribing of the oral contraceptive pill this may come in handy for family members who can't get a GP appointment in a timely manner
- Treatment for mild plaque psoriasis
- Shingles immunisation as well as treatment with antivirals if someone is suffering from shingles
- Travel health vaccination prescribing, along with other tailored travel health advice and medication management tips for specific destinations.

I hope this is helpful, but do reach out if I can assist further! Have a great week.
