held in Grafton on their colourful Parade Day on the first Saturday of November. Other attractions visited are: Fort
Scratchley in Newcastle, Fighter World in Williamtown, Slim Dusty Centre in Kempsey, Port Macquarie's Rainforest Park,
as well as a Koala Hospital. Coach from/to Sydney, four nights' accommodation and all meals (except lunch on Festival
Day in Grafton) included. Cost \$1575 ppts with \$394 single supplement.

Cost \$7,335 ppts, plus single supplement(SS) \$1,980 = \$9,315. Deposit is refundable less any tour expenses incurred up to 61 days prior to departure date.Final payment \$6,540 or \$8,520 (SS) due 19 June.No refund after final payment. Itinerary will be emailed totravelers. Price adjustments will be made for travelers choosing to continue Perth to Adelaide - see details below.

July Walk with Gillian:

Our next walk, which is scheduled for 1 July, will be led by Gillian Dockrill in Ian's absence. Please note the change of day to a Tuesday, which has been made to avoid a clash with our Christmas in July outing on 3 July. We will meet at 9.35am at Circular Quay, wharf 5, where we will catch the 9.45 ferry to Woolwich.

We will then walk through Woolwich, Woolwich Dock, Clark's Point Reserve, Woolwich Marina and Kelly's Bush. After weaving our way through Hunters Hill and under the end of the Fig Tree Bridge, we will arrive at the Hunters Hill Hotel, an excellent lunch spot. However, there are several coffee shops and a park for people looking for an alternative.
