November Walk with Ian: On Thursday 6 November we will meet at 9.35am at Circular Quay, wharf 2, where we will catch the 9.45am ferry to Watson's Wharf. We will walk to The Gap and then follow a concrete path up past Macquarie Lighthouse to Diamond Bay, where the recently re-opened walkway skirts the spectacular coastline. Although there is some street walking, we will continue to follow the coast on a mainly grassy track. The final couple of kilometres are beside the road to North Bondi, and those wishing to, can catch a bus for that section of the walk.

We will have lunch at the North Bondi RSL with views to match those from Icebergs, but at a fraction of the price. After lunch, we will catch the bus back to the city.

There are quite a few steps and slopes in the section up to Macquarie Lighthouse, but most of the remaining walk is fairly flat or downhill. There is a bus from Watson's Bay to Macquarie Lighthouse for any walkers wishing to avoid the climb. Walkers should wear sturdy shoes and take a hat, sunscreen, insect repellent, wet weather gear, water, a snack for morning tea and a picnic lunch (if applicable). It is essential that walkers take with them any medications which they may need on the walk.

October WOW Walk with Margaret: On Thursday 23 October we will meet at the Town Hall steps at 9:30am. We will take the train to Milson's Point and walk down to MacDougal Street to enjoy the magnificent Jacaranda trees in full bloom.
