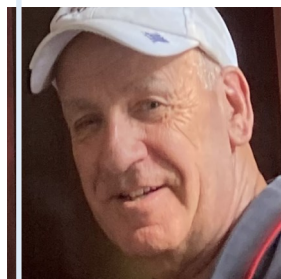

I missed your smiling faces at the last meeting but it was good to get my yearly dose of bronchitis out of the way early.

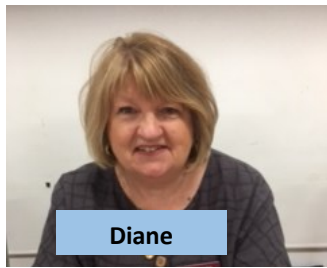
The morning tea at 3196 market went down well and always interesting to have a wander to check out the wares.

See you at the September meeting with my sun tan, cheers for now.

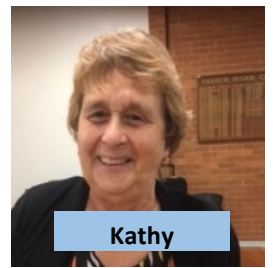

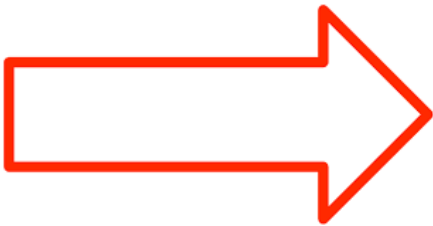
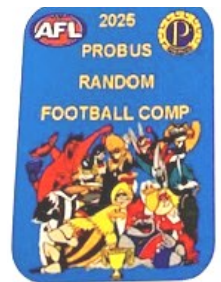
