A quick reminder to consider a committee position, no matter how minor, every little bit helps and much appreciated.

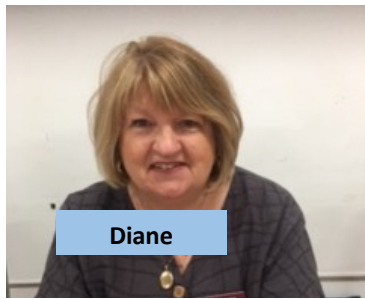
