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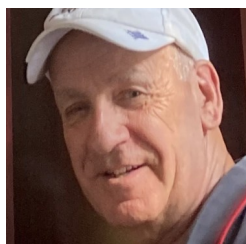

Well, the Norfolk Island holiday is over and they all returned in one piece, check out the photos of the fun and a lovely place to visit.

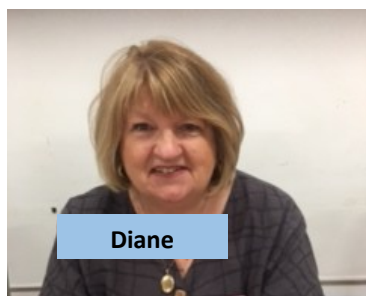
Outings this month at the Baxter Tavern for lunch and La Trang Vietnamese for a dinner went down well and we are always looking forward to more food outings.

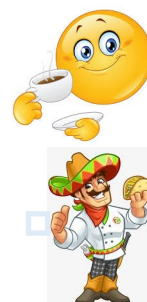

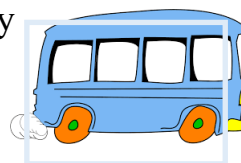

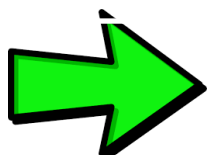
