

Spring will see our bike riding group warming up soon, there is also a movie outing on Friday 12th Sept. 10.15 for 10.30am at Hoyts, Frankston.


Please remember to bring some change for a Melbourne Cup barrier draw sweep, possible donation to our speaker and Christmas raffles at our October meeting.
