Our **Guest Speaker** and new member, Ron Pike (pictured with President Bob) spoke to his chosen topic, the Murrumbidgee Irrigation Scheme. After discussing the Murrumbidgee Scheme,





which was established in the early 1900s, Ron spoke more broadly about water resources on the east coast of Australia. This part of the country has an abundance of water, a significant amount of which flows out to sea. Efficient sources of power are currently being debated at the political level, with a focus on renewables, but with the abundance of rivers and mountains up and down the east coast, there are multiple opportunities for dams to be constructed to provide hydro-electric power. Ron made the point that it is 54 years since a dam was built on the east coast for hydro power.

Ron was thanked for his talk and presented with a certificate and gift by Speaker Liaison Officer, Allison Maberly-Smith.
