Australia Day Picnic

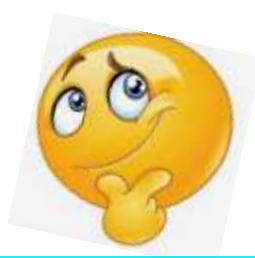
20 members enjoyed a twilight picnic at McKenzie Reserve. We played games, enjoyed great company and of course, the traditional Aussie BBQ
