

TECH TIPS -

How to take the perfect overhead shot with your iPhone/Android Camera



I-Phone: Open the Settings App. Scroll down and select Camera. Toggle on Grid. Exit the Camera App. Get your subject into view and lined up how you want in your grid. Slightly move and tilt your iPhone until the two plus symbols on your display line up and turn yellow. This indicates that your iPhone is level. It's useful to keep your elbows by your sides, and your feet braced apart for stability. Also, slowly releasing your breath before you take your photo helps prevent wiggling. Tap the Shutter button to snap your picture when you're ready.

Android phones such as Oppo: Open **Camera Settings**, choose **Composition assistance**, turn on **Level**. In the display, a white line will move between markers and will turn yellow when the phone is level."
