The Regal Theatre runs special monthly screenings of new release films for seniors on the last Wednesday of every month at 10:30am.

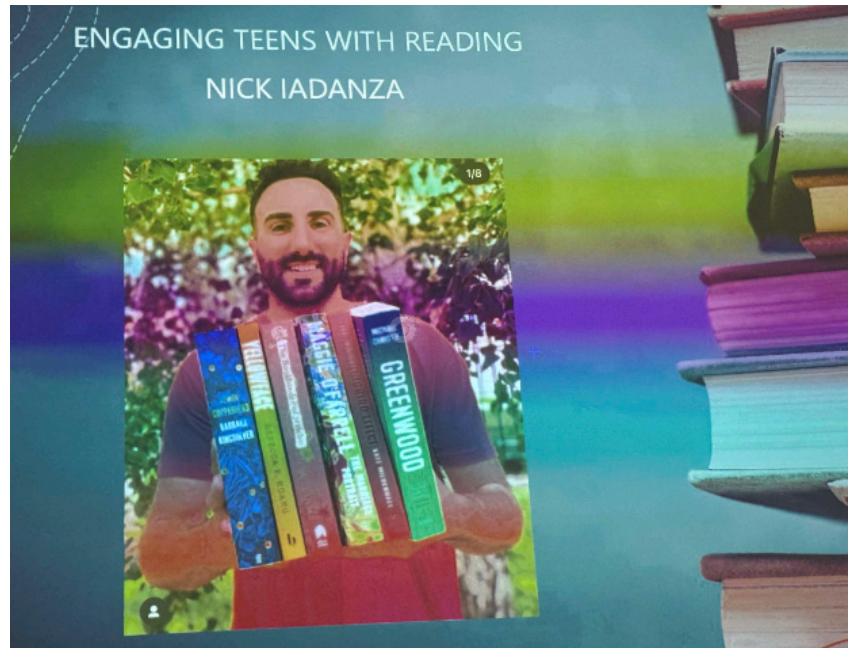
The cost is \$9:50 per ticket and includes tea/coffee and biscuits. Non-seniors are welcome to attend also at a cost of \$12:50.

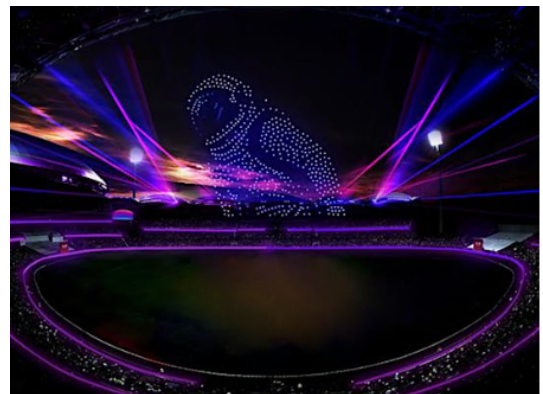
