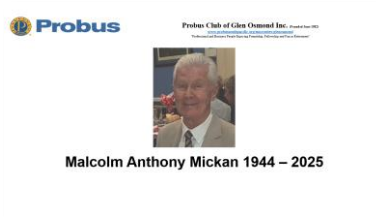


Vale to Malcolm Anthony Mikan 1944 – 2025

Eulogy by Brian Rice



Good morning, everyone, it is my privilege to present a short eulogy for the late Malcolm Anthony Mikan, who died a few weeks ago on 26th October.

Malcolm joined the Glen Osmond Probussouthpacific Club in November 2016 and was introduced by the late Ron Kitchen. He resigned in February 2025 due to failing health, when he moved to an Aged Care Facility.

I didn't know Malcolm very well, other than as a member here, and at several Christmas Lunches.

I did however, regularly, spot Malcolm and his good friend, the late Ron Kitchen, who was also a member of our Club, when they were lunching at the Norwood Hotel. It is one of my favourite lunching venues, and Malcolm and Ron were obviously having a good time, as they were always still chatting away, when it was time for me to leave.

Our sincere condolences go to Malcolm's wife, Pamela and his extensive family.

I can deduce from the Death Notices, that Malcolm and Pamela had three children and Malcolm was quote, *an exceptional and caring Step-father*, end quote, of four more children.

The Tribute notes that he was quote, *grand-Malc*, end quote, to eight grandchildren and quote, *great-Malc*, end quote, to two great-grandchildren.

The last two sentences in the Tribute say it all;

"Malcolm was a true hero during his illness.

A passionate loving man, he will be sadly missed by all that knew him."
