Our guest speakers for August were Nelson Dale and Matthew Morley of Pinnacle Podiatry in Gymea, who reminded us of the importance of maintaining foot health. They pointed out that balance and joint issues can be traced back to foot problems left untreated for too long.

They demonstrated easy exercises to improve our balance and reminded us that there is no one, definitive, great shoe brand; the only "great" shoes are designed for specific purposes and different types of feet, and they provided a range of these shoes for members to investigate. They also answered questions about common foot problems: corns and bunions, flat feet, hammer toes, ingrown toenails and the use of orthotics to support fallen arches.

In all it was an interesting presentation, and probably convinced us to be more aware of foot health and its importance in the ageing process.

Meeting held on Wednesday, August 20.

The topic was, 'Are reward programmes worth the effort?' These programmes are endemic. We all belong to one even if unknowingly. Woolworths has its Everyday Reward points; Coles Flybuys. In fact, most companies offer them, e.g. Myers, NRMA and Telstra. The programs, which are rated the best, are Qantas Frequent Flyers and Virgin Velocity points.

If we shop at companies, which have programmes, we pay for them even if we have not accessed them. There are two approaches: just join the programmes on offer from companies we already have some links to; the other is to look for offers, which offer a significant point bonus for joining. This is, I believe, called 'farming'. Generally, after a year, you can opt out of the offer but still keep the points.

We reached a consensus this time. By all means, be careful and vigilant. However, what we buy costs the same whether we belong to the company's reward program lor not. So, join up and reap the rewards.
