Uncover the vibrant soul of New South Wales on this unforgettable 7 day journey. Explore breathtaking silo art, wander through charming country towns, and soak in the stunning scenery that makes regional Australia so unique. Witness massive murals that bring local stories, culture and history to life.



The Silo Art Trail across New South Wales is a vibrant celebration of regional life. Towering silos painted by world-class artists have transformed small country towns into must-visit cultural destinations. These murals honour Indigenous history farming communities, native wildlife, and local heroes.

Our first 3 nights will be spent in Cowra. Nestled in the Lachlan Valley, Cowra is a town rich in history, tranquility, and natural beauty. Known for the poignant story of the Cowra POW Camp and its remarkable reconciliation with Japan, Cowra offers moving historical insights and peaceful spaces. Highlights include the exquisite Cowra Japanese Garden, the POW Theatre, and the blooming landscapes that surround the town. From here we will enjoy a day trip taking in the several key silo and mural sites of Murrumburrah, Grenfell and Eugowra.

Leaving Cowra, we travel to Tamworth visiting the towns of Wellington, Gulgong and Dunedoo along the way. We will spend two nights in Tamworth, taking in more silos as well as what this region has to offer.

Tamworth is a large prosperous regional city in the heart of the New England region. It has built a great reputation for its hospitality, especially during the Country Music Festival held in January each year. It is also home to the Australian Equine and Livestock Events Centre and has one of the busiest saleyards in the country. It has a rich rural history as the headquarters of the Australian Agricultural Company from the 1830's.



Our final destination is Pokolbin" From Tamworth, our route takes in a blend of artistic expression and equestrian heritage, set against the backdrop of captivating countryside. Nestled in the heart of the Hunter Valley, Pokolbin is a charming and picturesque destination renowned for its world-class wineries, gourmet food, and stunning scenery. Surrounded by rolling vineyards and framed by the Brokenback Mountain Range, it offers a relaxed and elegant country atmosphere.
