- To request leave of absence if you will be away for two or more consecutive meetings









He was in New York on the fateful day of September 11.




## RUMMIKUB - Friday 22 August - Castle Hill RSL Club, Lucy's Bar - 10am

### **Update on the Parking System at Castle Towers**



#### **Disability Parking Permit**

If you hold this permit, you receive free all-day parking

#### **Seniors Card**

Customers with a valid Seniors Card will receive an additional 1 hour to the standard free 3 hours parking

It was thought that keeping the stone close during dark hours repelled nighttime evil spirits.

- The gladioli has long been a symbol of strength, victory, healing, and honour. It has also been associated with moral character, remembrance, and intelligence. In Victorian times, romantics believed that the beauty of the gladiolus could pierce another's heart with love. In floral meanings, the flower also came to symbolize infatuation, love at first sight, and faithfulness.
- The Poppy which has a longtime symbol of remembrance. According to Greek mythology, the poppy was
