1 tablespoon olive oil 2 tablespoon butter 500 grams raw prawns 1/2 chopped onion or leek 2 cloves garlic 1/2 cup white wine

1/4 cup cream

1/3 cup of grated Parmesan

- 1. Melt oil and butter together in a medium large saucepan, over medium heat

- 5. Add 2/3 of the chicken stock and stir until absorbed, keep adding remaining stock, stirring each time - this should take about 15 minutes
- 6. Add prawns, cheese and cream
- 7. Stir until prawns have changed colour
- 8. Add salt and pepper to taste


