All aboard at 8.15 am for a 8.30 am departure from Ingleburn RSL Car Park we will travel to Penrith for morning tea on the banks of the Nepean River. Then it's off for a fascinating visit to the Museum of Fire. View a theatre screening and video displays before a guided tour through the museum which displays 2500 items ranging from fire appliances of all periods to documents and photographs.

Exhibitions of fire engines including "Big Ben" an 1891 steam fire engine made in London plus related material that shows the development of firefighting from the earliest days of the colony.

Reboarding the coach we travel the short distance to Penrith RSL Club for our lunch.

In the afternoon we have a guided tour of the Penrith Regatta Centre.
