HAWKESBURY WINDSOR RAMBLE

Wednesday 11th March, 2026

All aboard at 8.15 am for an 8.30 am departure from Ingleburn RSL Car Park. Join us on a fascinating and insightful day out with our Heritage Guide as we learn all about the discovery of the fertile Hawkesbury district.

Travelling to Ebenezer, our guide will share fascinating insights into the early settlers' experiences and the area's development. After a delicious morning tea we will visit Australia's oldest church, established in 1809. This Church has been beautifully restored and we will learn about its history from an Australian Historian and author, known for his work on local History in relation to the Hawkesbury region. We will also have time to visit the shop and schoolhouse.

Next we head to Wilberforce Town Square, where the layout of the original town with church, schoolhouse and cemetery are evident before moving on to Windsor. We will walk in the oldest town square and hear stories of scandal and intrigue before a driving tour of the area to view pioneer buildings as we hear many more stories before lunch.

After a main course lunch at Clarendon Tavern we stop at St Matthews Church, known for its beautiful Georgian architecture and said to be one of the best works of Architect Francis Greenway. The church is renowned for its historic graveyard, where many early settlers and notable figures are buried and we will tour the most interesting graves in the cemetery.
