


Some may remember Heather as a bus driver on the Broken Hill trip.

We left Marree in the south and flew north towards Cooper Creek inflow. This is the main source of water and flows south where it stops and builds back up to the north. Current levels estimated at 2 - 3 metres but when full can be as deep as 6-7 metres






The further south we flew, higher evaporation levels gave a more salt visible water scape. Birds were scarce. Evaporation levels can be up to 2 metres.
