Eltham Cemetery

On a sunny, albeit windy day in September, 20 of us enjoyed a guided tour of the beautiful and tranquil 12 acres of the Eltham Cemetery. It's amazing how interesting a cemetery can be when you have got someone as knowledgeable as Jim Connor sharing his wealth of information.

During our leisurely stroll, Jim showed us several resting places of people who played a part in the history of Eltham, along with a lot of interesting background stories. His enlightened commentary provided a wonderful perspective to the visit. Some of the memorable names on the grave sites include Sweeney, Shillinglaw, Knox and Lawlor. The wall of artwork is truly wonderful, depicting both the historical and also more recent scenes telling the Eltham story.

After this we were off to the oldest public building in Eltham, being the Eltham Courthouse which was built in 1850 and has recently been authentically restored, retaining many original features. Here Jim told us about the interesting life of this building and its goings on over the years, including a reenactment of a typical case.

Your President was chosen to stand in the dock and was accused of organising clandestine meetings of unsavoury people and inciting insurrection. For the record her peers found her guilty, despite her weak defence that all she was doing was trying to start a Probus Club.

Of course, it wouldn't be a Probus outing without food playing an important part. To that end, we wandered off to the Eltham hotel and enjoyed each other's company over lunch. Several people who couldn't make it to the tours joined us for lunch.
