A vote on the adoption of the two documents will take place on the 3rd November. An approval will mean the Constitution and Standing Resolutions take effect for 1st January 2026.

It is also that time of the year when we ask members to consider seeking nominations for the 2026 Committee in order to ensure the Club remains in a strong ongoing position. Much support is available for those who go onto the Committee who are a very collegial group.
