Dear members, I write your birthday anecdotes to accompany your birthday. They are for all to read and enjoy so please do so. Happy Birthday to all, Andy.

2nd. Lynne Jones. You share with Peter O'Toole, Irish actor, born in Leeds UK to an Irish father and a Scottish mother. He lived in Ireland. On this day in 1997, Ski instructor Stuart Diver was rescued 65 hours after the Thredbo landslide on 30/7/1997. He was the sole survivor. 18 people were killed, including his wife Sally.

<u>5th. Dina Brouwer</u>. You share with Harold Holt, Australian Prime Minister in 1966. On this day in 1944, the Cowra NSW breakout occurred. It was an attempt to escape by approximately 1,100 Japanese prisoners of war which resulted in the deaths of 234 prisoners and four Australian soldiers.

7th. Jackie Rose. You share with Billie Burke, American actress known for her role as the good witch in the movie "The Wizard of Oz". On this day in 1928, the Graf Zeppelin Airship takes off for a trip around the World.

<u>10th. Fred Edmonds</u>. You share with Herbert Hoover, American President in 1929. Then in 1966, the first American satellite, Lunar Orbiter 1. It was designed to photograph the Moon's surface for potential landing sites for the Apollo missions.

13th. Mavis Mumford. You share with Annie Oakley, American markswoman who could hit the thin edge of a playing card at 30 paces. On this day in 1814, Britain took over the Cape of Good Hope from the Dutch.

14th. Judy De Jong. You share with Sarah Brightman, an English classical crossover soprano singer and actress. On this day in 1958, the death of Big Billy Broonzy, American blues singer, songwriter, and guitarist.

14th. Neil Chalmers. You share with Dave Crosby who was an American singer, songwriter and guitarist. Formed the "Byrds" and then "Crosby, Stills & Nash". On this day in 1861, William Landsborough organises a relief expedition to find missing explorers Burke and Wills.

20th. Dawn Bloomfield. You share with Bunny Austin, British tennis player and four times Davis Cup winner. On this day in 1857, the Dunbar is wrecked at the entrance to Sydney Harbour, killing 121 passengers.

20th. Glenys Forsyth. You share with Jack Teagarden who was an American jazz trombonist, singer & composer. On this day in 1836, Colonel William Light arrives in South Australia to survey a site for the first settlement.

21st. Faye Campbell. You share with Princess Margaret, was the younger sister of Queen Elizabeth II. On this day in 1976, 25-year-old Mary Langdon joins East Sussex fire brigade & becomes Britain's first female fireman.

<u>21st. Jill Middleton</u>. You share with William "Count" Basie who was an American jazz pianist, organist, bandleader, and composer. On this day in 1903, Tom Fetch and M C Krarup complete the USA transcontinental journey from San Francisco to New York City in a Packard automobile.

26th Helga Eisenhammer. You share with Prince Albert, the husband of Queen Victoria. On this day in 1989, a very special car "Mini" (Morris Mini-Minor) had its 30th birthday. Few heads were turned when the first wonder was unveiled with just 20,000 cars, but by 1989 it had made 381,000 cars.

<u>26th. Barbara Russell</u>. You share with Lee de Forest, who was an American inventor who was widely honoured as the "father of radio" and the "grandfather of television." On this day in 1957, the Soviets announce the first successful ballistic missile tests have taken place.

27th. Derinda Jarrett. You share with Samuel Goldwyn who produced Hollywood's first major motion picture. On this day in 1859, the World's first successful oil well is drilled by Edwin Drake at Titusville, Pennsylvania.

<u>31st. Bob Ludgate</u>. You share with Sir Bernard Lovell who was an English physicist and radio astronomer. On this day in 1908, the great W G Grace retired at the age of 60 from first class cricket after 43 years (44 seasons). He scored 54,896 runs, including 126 centuries. Magnificent!
