#### REPORT: NORFOLK ISLAND TOUR



Famous for its pine trees and the 1789 "Mutiny on the Bounty", scenically there was no shortage of beautiful forests, valleys, and look outs over craggy shorelines to the stunningly blue Pacific Ocean.

The highlights of the trip, apart from an amazing Cyclorama painted by 3 local artists and depicting a 360° viewing of the Bounty's voyage, were meeting and mixing with the locals. Most of our guides and hosts were 7th or 8th generation descendants of Bounty mutineers, including many with the surname Christian. They are proud of their heritage and never seem to tire of sharing their history with visitors. They are quirky, proud, self-sufficient and very happy people, good senses of humour with many tales to tell. Some stories did have variations depending on the driver of the day. We dined in their homes and were entertained by some very talented singers, guitar players, dancers and a Tahitian princess (there is not space to describe Princess Alison, you can ask one of us about her).

We dined on local fresh fish, beef, salads and vegetables in season, avocados grow in abundance but tomatoes and potatoes due to weather conditions were in short supply, sweet potatoes were plentiful. Fresh milk @ \$20.00 a litre was also in short supply, we survived on long life. Cows roam freely along the roadsides but it is not profitable to run a dairy farm and they are farmed for beef. We did have an interesting morning doing a "Farm to table tour" I did hear it referred to as Steak and Eggs.

I'm sure my travel companions would agree it was a fun, enjoyable and historically informative trip. I haven't even mentioned the ghosts!
