


DECEMBER 2025

I should also acknowledge the efforts of those people, Anita Dahl in particular, who regularly give me empty plastic bottles etc for the NSW Return It campaign which refunds 10 cents on every returned plastic and glass bottle up to two litres (except milk containers which should go into the normal recycling). The returned bottles are then redeemed and the money raised goes into the Funds of the Lake George Support Brigade Logistics Team. This is their only source of income for purchasing minor items to provide operational service support to the eighteen firefighting combat brigades within our District (roughly approximating to the QPRC Local Government Area). I'm always happy to accept more, with or without their lids!

IN SUMMARY

By all these minor acts and contributions, we jointly save resources, reduce landfill, provide support to others less well-off and support our firefighting volunteers. We do all this while hardly inconveniencing ourselves at all. What a great spirit.
