The highest bid at the end of the auction time 'wins' the item.

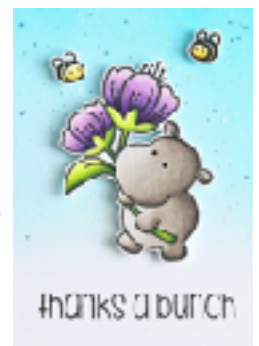


You will then need cash, (smaller denominations of notes or coins, please) to pay for your win. Some unsold items may be grouped for a bidding session.

Di's Pattern for Fingerless Gloves

8 ply wool no 8 needles
Cast on 42 stitches
Knit 20 rows k2 p2 rib
Knit 20 rows stocking stitch
Knit 10 rows k2 p2 rib
Cast off, sew up side seam
but leave opening for the thumb.
