Francis, who is the President of VADSA gave us very informative and interesting information on the work the organisation has done since 1983 and their constant work on getting the Bill passed in 2021. They continue to work with other organisations, the law and the strict eligibility criteria and safeguards determined by Parliament.

VADSA's Aim, as set out in their Bulletin (copies of which were available for Members) states that their aim is the choice of voluntary assisted dying for people suffering unbearably from an illness, injury or disability. It was very interesting to note their connection to SA Health and the intersections between VAD, palliative and end-of-life care.


