World Affairs Discussion – Positives and Negatives of Artificial Intelligence (AI) and can the older generation benefit?

Twenty people gathered to listen to Associate Professor Dianne McGrath, from CSU. She gave us a clear explanation of what AI is, where it has come from, and why it seems to be everywhere at the moment. It is a big topic and while we may feel a bit left out of these rapid technology developments our speaker reminded us that we all have a responsibility for how future use of AI will evolve. AI uses everything it sees, but it can't determine what is true or false, so we need to be responsible about what is posted and amplified – the more something gets pushed around the internet, the higher it goes up the AI index.

We need to develop skills in scepticism and teach that to the next generation. As an example Dr McGrath introduced us to this **older, regional, Australian, image** generated by Co-pilot, which decided that the image would be that of a male, using the prompts in bold.
