THE BEST OF CLARE VALLEY & THE BAROSSA

Day 1 – Adelaide & Clare Valley

We depart Sydney around midday and fly to Adelaide, before travelling north through the countryside towards the Clare Valley. Along the way we'll make a brief comfort stop in Gawler, before continuing directly to our accommodation at the Clare Country Club. After checking in, we come together for dinner, marking the beginning of our South Australian wine journey.

Day 2 – Burra & Paulett's Wines

This morning, we travel to the historic copper mining settlement of **Burra**, a living museum of 19th-century life and a National Heritage-listed town. We set off on a two-hour guided coach tour, hearing fascinating stories of early settlers. After exploring its historic buildings, we enjoy lunch in the railway station. Our afternoon takes us to Paulett's Wines, where we sample cool-climate varietals while soaking in beautiful valley views. Returning to our hotel, the evening is free to relax and share dinner together on site.

Day 3 – Mintaro & Barossa Valley

Today we travel south, stopping at Mintaro to explore its heritage-listed village with a guided tour that reveals its colonial character. After enjoying lunch, we continue into the world-renowned Barossa Valley. The afternoon is free to explore or relax at our accommodation. Tonight, we gather for dinner and look forward to the wine experiences ahead.

Day 4 – Maggie Beer & Barossa Icons

We begin at Maggie Beer's Farm Shop, where tastings showcase the passion of one of Australia's culinary icons. Our day continues with visits to Seppeltsfield and Yalumba, enjoyed in two smaller groups before everyone comes together for lunch and tasting at Pindarie Estate. The afternoon sees our groups rotate for a second round of tastings, offering balance and variety. In the evening, we gather once more for dinner, savouring the flavours of this celebrated wine region.

Day 5 – Tanunda & Angaston

This morning is free to enjoy Tanunda at leisure, with time to browse boutiques, cafés, and galleries. At midday, the group will transfer to the picturesque township of **Angaston**, home to sandstone cottages, artisanal food producers, and panoramic views of the Eden Valley. Enjoy **lunch at leisure** and time to wander the high street, visit local cafés, or browse artisan shops.

Day 6 – Barossa Chateau & Grand Wineries

Our morning begins at Barossa Chateau, where we enjoy a tour and Devonshire tea surrounded by art and gardens. We then divide into two groups for wine tastings: one at Chateau Tanunda and the other at Jacob's Creek, before everyone comes together for lunch at Kies family wines. We'll enjoy lunch in their adjoining Café, overlooking the vineyards, whilst being guided through a relaxed tasting of their small batch wines. In the afternoon, the groups rotate, allowing us to experience the alternate winery, ensuring everyone enjoys the best of both. We return to our hotel for dinner, closing another day of indulgence in the Barossa.

Day 7 – Adelaide Hills & Return to Sydney

After breakfast we farewell the Barossa, travelling through the scenic Adelaide Hills. Afterwards, we continue to Adelaide Airport for our flight to Sydney, carrying home lasting memories of fine wines, gourmet meals, and shared experiences.
