Day 1 – Flight & Arrival: Welcome to South Australia

Meet your fellow travellers and On Course Tours host at Sydney Airport for your flight to Adelaide. Upon arrival, enjoy a scenic transfer into the countryside. Stop for a hearty lunch at a welcoming local hotel in the township of **Gawler** - South Australia's oldest country town, known for its heritage buildings and charming village feel. Visit a nearby museum that showcases the town's rich colonial past. In the afternoon, we will continue to our accommodation in the Clare Valley and settle in before dinner on site.

Day 2 – Exploring Burra: A Town Frozen in Time

This morning, travel to the historic copper mining settlement of **Burra**, a living museum of 19th-century life and a National Heritage-listed town. Enjoy a **2-hour guided coach tour** uncovering iconic sites including the Redruth Gaol, miners' dugouts, and heritage cottages. Afterward, enjoy a hearty lunch in the beautifully restored **Burra Railway Station**, full of vintage character. On the return journey to Clare, stop for a wine tasting at the scenic and award-winning **Paulett's Wines**, nestled in the Polish Hill River region. Known for its exceptional Rieslings and welcoming atmosphere, it's a delightful introduction to Clare Valley wine.

Day 3 – Mintaro & Barossa Bound

Depart Clare and begin the day with a guided visit to the quaint village of **Mintaro** - one of South Australia's oldest and best-preserved heritage towns. Wander its cobbled laneways and admire bluestone buildings that speak to its mining and agricultural past. Enjoy a hearty lunch at the charming **Magpie & Stump Hotel** before continuing to the world-renowned Barossa Valley. Arrive at your accommodation and enjoy dinner on site.
