Speaker: Peter Gray – (October 2025 TBC)

Subject: Local Author and Engineer with BHP

A retired geo-technical engineer, Peter mines his experience of working with BHP to create thrillers based around the Australian diamond industry, and specifically the rare and beautiful pink Argyle diamonds. Speaker: Peter Moran – (November 2025 TBC)

Subject: Local Historians presentation on the history of shell harbour, Port Kembla and surrounding areas. Port Kembla's history is intricately tied to its role as a major industrial hub, particularly for steel production and as a critical port. The area, originally inhabited by the Dharawal Indigenous Australians, transformed dramatically after European settlement. The establishment of the steelworks and the port transformed Port Kembla into the industrial heart of the Illawarra region

Speaker: Milton Lewis (Ecologist) – (February 2026 TBC)

Subject: Speaker is from the Shoalhaven and his presentation is on Butterfly's. Butterflies begin their life cycle as eggs laid on leaves. After hatching, the caterpillar grows by eating and shedding its skin until it forms a chrysalis, entering the pupa stage. Eventually, a butterfly emerges, and its wings dry and prepare for flight.
