Our guest speaker last month was Dmitry Levin, Co-Founder of KISA (Keeping It Simple Always). The company KISA have developed an Emergency Communication Device – a basic phone for seniors or people with disabilities to feel safe and keep in touch. Each phone is customised to the individual's need. Users can access the latest technology enabling them to live more independently and connect with their support network.

Spot speaker

Dr Alison Tokita, a new member of the Glen Iris Probus Club, gave us an insight into the various genres of Japanese Music and its place in traditional and contemporary Japanese society. She described it as exotic music based on 7th and 8th century medieval period.

Japan's musical traditions stretch back over centuries, and is a richly diverse tapestry of cultures, such as Japanese folk music, court music, Japanese theatrical music and Japanese instrumental music. Dr Tokita also runs a short course at the Stonnington U3A if you wish to explore this fascinating history further.
