Cream of Tomato Soup

Serves 2-4

Source: Soups cookbook

8-10 Roma tomatoes (or 2 x 440 cans tomato, with juice)

2 teaspoons sugar

1 teaspoon salt

2 tablespoons plain flour

1 tablespoon vegetable oil

2 teaspoons ground coriander

2 teaspoons cumin

½ teaspoon cayenne pepper or chilli, or to taste

250mls double cream

fresh ground black pepper, to taste

chopped coriander or basil leaves for garnish

chopped fresh tomato for garnish (optional)

- 1. Puree tomatoes, sugar, salt and flour in a food processor
- 2. Heat oil in saucepan. Add the spices and cook until fragrant, about one minute.
- 3. Add cream and pureed tomatoes.
- 4. Simmer stirring for few minutes, until slightly thickened. Season with pepper.
- 5. Serve sprinkled with cilantro or basil and fresh tomato for garnish, if desired.

Variation

For tomato and coconut soup, replace the cream with 1 cup of coconut cream.
