

Harbour history under full sail

SELF-confessed ship tragic Ray Rees was under full sail as he regaled us with tales from the Sydney Heritage Fleet.

We are a living museum for the research, acquisition, conservation, restoration, education and operation of Australia's continuing maritime history, he said.

The Fleet's oldest vessel, the 1874 iron barque <u>James Craig</u>, has been fully restored and regularly puts to sea under full sail. The Fleet also operates three of the most historically significant vessels on Sydney Harbour: the 1902 steam tug <u>Waratah</u>, the 1902 VIP steam launch <u>Lady</u> <u>Hopetoun</u> and the 1903 schooner <u>Boomerang</u>.

Under restoration are the 1912 ferry <u>Kanangra</u>, the 1950s wooden speed boat <u>Kookaburra II</u> and the 1927 pilot vessel <u>John Oxley</u>.

The Fleet also has 55 small heritage boats and one of the largest collections of marine engines in Australia which are being restored and conserved.

We're always looking for memberships and more volunteers across a wide variety of skills and needs, said Ray.

A major source of revenue are heritage cruises – with this club already signed up for the jacaranda cruise in November aboard the *Lady Hopetoun*.
