Some of us participated in decorating rocks and CD's that she had supplied for that purpose. These will placed in the laneways.**

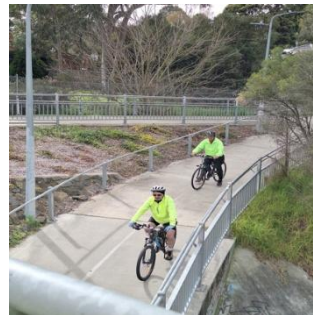




BEEN AND SEEN

Our August lunch was at the Bentleigh RSL with our Club members enjoying good food and fellowship.

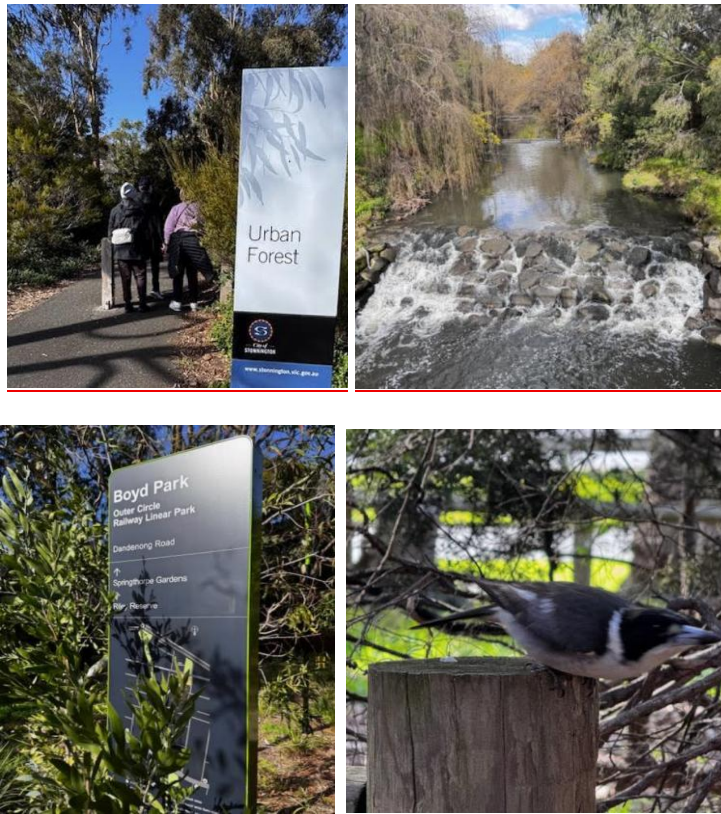




BEEN AND SEEN – OUR WALKING CLUB
