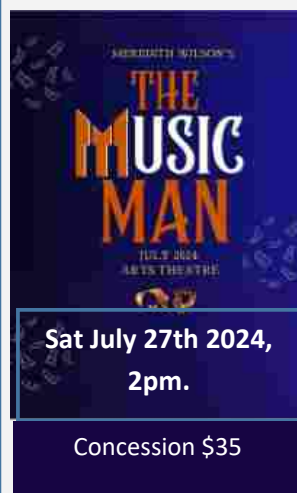

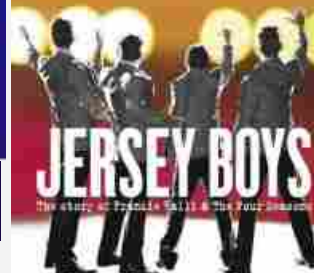

History Of Monarto Safari Park

- Originally part of Monarto Satellite City site, leased to the Royal Zoological Society of SA.
- Opened in 1983 as a breeding and pasture area.
- Officially opened to the public in 1993.
- Home to more than 550 animals roaming in what for zoos are very large areas. It's an escape from the city that immerses visitors in a natural safari-style setting.
- Has celebrated outstanding breeding success with rare and endangered exotic and native animals.
- Owned and operated by a conservation charity, Zoos SA.
