

Coach Tour to Mildura


5 nights & 6 days. Depart Sat 14th Sept 2024, return Thurs 19th Sept 2024.







Graham was born at Ashford Hospital on 29th June 1937. His family lived in Glenelg, and he attended Glenelg Infants School and then Ethelton Primary School. His family moved from Semaphore to Whyalla in 1948 but later returned to Semaphore. He attended Woodville High School from 1950 to 1952.

After high school he joined the Public Service and was with them for 20 years. He married Margaret his first wife in 1963 and they had a son. They lived in Ridgehaven from 1968 to 1988 when they moved to Fulham.

Graham's work in the Public Service included road transport and traffic issues.

Sadly, Margaret died in 1991.

Graham was active in Rotary, playing golf and he joined Probus on 16 December 1992.

He married his second wife Margaret in 1993. They travelled overseas or within Australia on each wedding anniversary for 25 years. Unfortunately, Margaret became ill in later years with dementia and sadly died in July 2023.
